Subject: **2025 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS**

Date: February 5, 2025

1. As provided in the Republic Act (RA) No. 10533 titled An Act Enhancing the Philippine Basic Education System by Strengthening Its Curriculum and Increasing the Number of Years for Basic Education, Appropriating Funds Therefore and for Other Purposes and DepEd Order (DO) No. 021 s. 2019 titled Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program, DFOT serves as a clear and proactive reinforcement of the teaching and learning process, reflecting the significant association between what the learners learned in school and what they actually performed and produced during this activity. Consistent with the Department's dedicated efforts to producing functionally literate and holistically developed Filipinos, all DFOT events are aligned with the essential learning competencies and standards of the K to 12 Curriculum.
2. In line with the goal of delivering quality, relevant, inclusive, and responsive basic education, the Schools Division of Davao del Norte through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the **2025 Division Festival of Talents (DFOT)** on March 5, 2025 at Kapalong West District and Hermigildo A. Baluyo Cultural Center, Tagum City.
3. The contest venues are the following, to wit:

4. The Education Program Supervisors will coordinate closely with the District Coordinating Principal (DCP) and School Heads for the details and other preparation of the respective venues.

Likewise, EPS in-charge of the learning areas will take charge of pocket meetings with their counterparts in the districts to discuss mechanics and guidelines of events to be contested, and to organize its Technical Working Group (TWG) to plan for the smooth facilitation of the different contest events.
6. There is **no registration fee** for the 2025 DFOT. Travelling and other incidental expenses incurred during the activity shall be charged against local funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. In adherence to all policies, everyone is encouraged to continuously support and value equality and diversity (**Equal Opportunity Principle**) within the Department. In the same manner, Project W.A.T.C.H will also be observed.
