Subject: **PARTICIPATION OF SDO-DAVAO DEL NORTE IN THE TRAINING OF CAMPUS JOURNALISTS CUM REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE 2025**

Date: February 05, 2025

1. Attached is the Regional Memorandum CLMD-2025-022 dated January 14, 2025, titled, “*Training of Campus Journalists cum Regional Schools Press Conference 2025*”, and Regional Memorandum CLMD-2025-063 titled, “*Adjustments on the Timelines of the Training of Campus Journalists cum Regional Schools Press Conference*”, dated January 30, 2025, informing the field of the participation of SDO-Davao del Norte in the said activity on **March 17-21, 2025 at Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur**. Attached is the list of Campus Journalists, School Paper Advisers, and other Delegation Staff.
2. This year’s theme for 2025 RSPC is “**Exploring Young Minds thru Campus Journalism Shapes Social Responsibility**”, and pursuant to RA 7079 otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act, the conference aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of journalism through skilled execution in various platforms (i.e. print, broadcast, online);
 - b. recognize the role of journalism in advocating for social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - c. promote fair and ethical use of media as tenets of responsible journalism;
 - d. foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through healthy and friendly competitions; and
 - e. provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers.
3. Found in the enclosures of the Regional Memorandum are the general guidelines, timelines, and adjusted timelines for RSPC, guidelines for the Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists, and Mobile Journalism.
4. The School Paper shall be submitted in PDF Format via Google Drive with a certificate of circulation in print/ pdf duly signed by the principal/school head. Schools that have 2025 RSPC Qualifiers shall strictly follow the “**No School Paper, No Student Contestant**” and ensure that all participants have published school paper both online and in print.
5. A Registration fee of Eight Hundred Pesos Only (**Php 800.00**) for each participant (Campus Journalist and School Paper Adviser/Coach) shall be chargeable against the Provincial

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Special Education Fund (SEF) subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations and to be remitted to the Cashier of the Regional Office. The registration fee shall be collected on or before **February 06, 2025**.

6. Membership Fees of One Hundred Pesos (**Php 100.00**) for the School Publication Advisers (SPA) and Ninety Pesos (**Php 90.00**) for Campus Journalists shall be charged against the association funds of The Davao del Norte Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers Association, Inc. (DNESSPAA, Inc.)
7. Meals, snacks, and travel expenses of the participants, and other incidental fees during the 2025 RSPC and other Division and Regional training/activities before and relative to the conduct of 2025 RSPC shall be charged against School MOOE, SEF, PTA, and other local funds, still subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. T-shirts (with unified Division design) are optional and still chargeable against School MOOE, SEF, PTA, and other local funds, still subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. Participants shall secure authority to travel signed by the school head and the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS). It is advised that participants involved shall bring their beddings, clothing, personal hygiene kits, and eating utensils to be used. Campus Journalists shall secure parental consent to join the activity.
10. Further details and additional Memoranda may be released relative to the SDOs' participation in 2025 RSPC.
11. Classes of the SPAs/Coaches who shall attend the 2025 RSPC and other related School-based, Division, and regional training shall be arranged accordingly to avoid disruption of classes, adhering to the policy of *"No disruption of classes, pursuant to the provision under DepEd Order (DO) 9 s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase/Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith"*.
12. Service Credits shall be granted to the teacher participants (DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s 2004) for services rendered during the weekend, and holidays.
13. **For Other details and guidelines related to the conduct of 2025 RSPC, refer to Regional Memorandum CLMD-2025-022, Regional Memorandum CLMD-2025-063, Division Memorandum No. 0027 s. 2025 and other related memoranda.**
14. Everyone is highly encouraged to continually support and recognize the value of equality and diversity of all personnel while complying with the directives set forth by this office.
15. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.



**General Guidelines of the Training of Journalists cum
2025 Regional Schools Press Conference**

A. Eligibility

1. Top five (5) division winners of the individual writing contests;
2. The first and second place winners in Group Contests;
3. School Publication Advisers;
4. Division Campus Journalism Focal Persons; and
5. Regional Technical Working Group.

SDOs are enjoined to strictly follow the "**No School Paper, No Student Contestant**" ensuring that all participants have their respective school paper. School paper must be published in print or electronically which shall be the basis in school paper category evaluation.

B. Events to be contested:

1. **Individual Contests** such as News Writing, Editorial Writing, Feature Writing, Sports Writing, Copyreading and Headline Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Photojournalism, Science and Technology Writing and Column Writing in English and Filipino of both elementary and secondary levels;
2. **Group Contests** such as Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting and Collaborative Desktop Publishing (for elementary and secondary level); Online Publishing Contest, and TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting (for secondary level);
3. **Mobile Journalism** in English and Filipino for Secondary level only;
4. Search for **Outstanding School Paper Advisers (SPAs) and Campus Journalists (CJs)**;
5. **School Paper Category** which includes six (6) sections: News Section, Features Section, Editorial Section, Sports Section, Science and Technology Section and Layout and Page Design; and
6. **Best Display Booth** highlighting best practices and achievements from previous NSPC editions. This allows divisions to share successes, inspire others, and exchange ideas.

C. Registration and Membership Fees

A registration fee of **Eight Hundred Pesos only (Php 800.00)** per participant shall be remitted to the Cashier of Regional Office on or before **January 31, 2025**, to defray expenses for certificates, medals, plaques, trophies, honoraria of judges (Individual, Group and School Paper Contest), accommodations, assistance to host schools and meals.

Membership fee of **One Hundred Pesos (Php 100.00)** for the **SPA** and **Ninety Pesos (Php 90.00)** for **CJ** shall be collected by the DRASPAI Treasurer due on **February 14, 2025**. These are all chargeable against School's Maintenance and other Operating Expenses/ local/school/ Special Education Fund, School Campus Journalism Funds and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations



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D. Meals, Transportation and Other Expenses

Meals, transportation and other related expenses of the division delegates shall be managed by each division. Billeting quarters will designate kitchen or cooking areas. However, delegates have the option to contract food catering service providers.

E. Billeting Quarters

Billeting Schools will be secured by the Barangay Protection Office and should have Child Protection Desk and proper Waste Management System.

All participants shall bring own bedding. Schools used as billeting quarters and contest venues shall adopt the **blended learning modality**.

F. Awarding

The top five winners in all events per level per medium shall be recognized and the points from individual and group contests shall be included in the computation of the overall scores following the guidelines. However, only the **first-place winners** in all events will represent the Region in the 2025 NSPC.

Only the top performing divisions in individual and group events and the overall winners shall be declared during the Awarding Ceremony. Winners for the individual and group events shall be declared in the designated contest venues.

G. Disqualification Rules

Maintaining honesty and integrity is crucial. Here are some common disqualification rules related to dishonesty:

- a. **Cheating:** Any form of cheating, such as using unauthorized materials or communicating with coaches or external individual and parties.
- b. **Plagiarism:** This Department reiterates its stand to disqualify school paper found to have copied and published texts, graphics, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources. The disqualification covers all sections of the school paper whether they are published in print or electronically. The Division Supervisors In-Charge of campus journalism shall be responsible for this aspect.
- c. **Violation of Guidelines:** Not adhering to the stipulated guidelines, such as those related to the technical, format or content of submissions, can also lead to disqualification.

The decision of the board of judges in these matters is typically final and irrevocable. These rules help ensure that the school press conference is fair and that the work presented is original and truthful.

CRITERIA FOR THE SEARCH FOR MOST OUTSTANDING SCHOOL PAPER ADVISER

1. The Regional Office shall conduct the selection for one Outstanding School Paper Adviser and one Outstanding Campus Journalist for both Secondary and Elementary levels.
2. Each division should have only one entry for every category based on the criteria provided by the Regional Office.
3. Candidates shall be ranked based on the total points garnered. The top three (3) shall be given the following equivalent points, for consideration in the computation of the overall standing of the division, to wit:
 1st place – 5 points 2nd place – 3 points 3rd place – 1 point
4. The Selection Committee shall be composed of the following: 1 Chair: Chief of CLMD, Members Regional Coordinator of Campus Journalism, one Regional Education Program Supervisor, and President of the Association of Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers as needed.
5. Each division shall have one (1) entry per category (CJ/ SPA- elementary/ secondary) for the search. Deadline for submission of pertinent documents will be on **February 6, 2025** at CLMD Office, DepEd RO XI, Torres St. Davao City and Face to face Interview of applicants for the Search for Outstanding School Paper Adviser and Campus Journalist shall be on **February 13, 2025**.

Basic Qualification: Must have been a school paper adviser for at least three (3) consecutive years, immediately prior to the search

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Enclosure 5. Mobile Journalism Guidelines

1. The Mobile Journalism Exhibition aims to empower campus journalists to create, edit, and produce timely and relevant news features with the use of just their smartphones, hence without the expense of traditional high-cost equipment.
2. Each SDO shall have two (2) participants, one for English and the other for Filipino. They must be selected from the **individual or group events** of the **secondary level** only.
3. The participants will be given time to shoot, edit, and produce a story on a topic that will be provided by the Management Committee.
4. Each entry must be recorded, edited, and completed with any smartphone running on iOS or Android and **using any video-editing app (capcut free version)**.
5. Each entry must run from **1 to 2 minutes** and shall revolve around the topic that will be given a week before the conference. **The preparation time is 4 hours. News style**
6. All submissions must be original and free from any intellectual property/copyright issues.
7. All participants must attest that they are submitting work produced with **only smartphones and apps**. The Board of Judges reserves the right to disqualify entries that cannot be verified and at their absolute discretion.
8. The decision of the Board of Judges is **final and irrevocable**.
9. All submissions will be the property of the Department of Education and may be used for educational and publicity purposes.
