Date: June 27, 2025

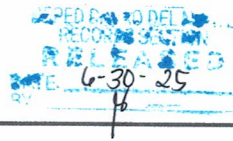

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 6380, an act of declaring **July 1<sup>st</sup>** of each year as a public holiday in the provinces of Davao Oriental, Davao del Sur, and Davao del Norte, this office informs the participation of all non-teaching and identified teaching personnel in the **Civic Parade of the 58<sup>th</sup> Araw ng Davao del Norte**.
2. The identified teacher-participants will serve as EMCEEs of the five stations to recognize and acknowledge participating organizations/agencies in the parade. Likewise, emcees will convene at the division office on June 30, 2025, at 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon.
3. The parade will start at 5:00 a.m. on July 2025, DepEd was assigned in Group 13 and will assemble at 4:45 a.m. near Tagum City Historical and Cultural Center.
4. The list of participants is enclosed in this memorandum.
5. Attending participants shall be provided with a Service Credits/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) as the activity falls on a Holiday based on DepEd Order (DO) No. 053, s. 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Service Credits to Teachers, and DO No. 084, s. 2003 entitled Addendum to DO No. 053, s. 22003, and CSC & DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, "Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered for the non-teaching personnel.
6. Transportation and other expenses incurred by the participants in the activity shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. In adherence to all policies, everyone is encouraged to continuously support and value equality and diversity (**Equal Opportunity Principle**) within the Department. In the same manner, Project W.A.T.C.H. will also be observed.
