Subject: **ENDORSEMENT ON THE SCREENING OF ISANG KOMEDYA SA LANGIT**

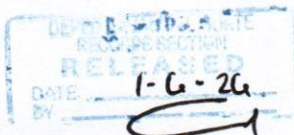

In this regard, we respectfully seek the support of your good office in facilitating the screening of this film, in accordance with:


