
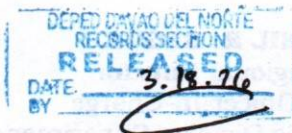

Relative to Memorandum No. OM-OUOPS-2025-02-06828 dated October 30, 2025, entitled *Implementation of the Asian Development Bank-Supported Digital Learning and Infrastructure Support Project in Partnership with Khan Academy Philippines*, the Department of Education hereby announces the **additional twenty (20) Pathfinder Schools** that shall be part of this project **starting School Year (SY) 2026-2027**. The list of these schools is attached as Annex A.

Together with the thirty-four (34) Pathfinder Schools that commenced participation in SY 2025-2026, and additional 20 schools will be added for the SY 2026-2027 implementation, a total of fifty-four (54) Pathfinder Schools across 17 regions of the country will benefit from the project. The project focuses on enabling effective use of Khan Academy's learning platform, including Khanmigo, its AI-powered assistant for teachers and tutor for learners, with targeted infrastructure support provided only where necessary, based on school needs. The project also aims to strengthen teachers' capacity to deliver technology-enabled and data-informed instruction that supports DepEd's Revised K-10 Curriculum, thereby enhancing teaching and learning in Mathematics and Science.
