IMPLEMENTATION OF PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST MPOX

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisor, Curriculum Implementation Division
Public Schools District Supervisor
School Heads, Integrated and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

- In compliance with Regional Memorandum ESSD-2025-157 issued by the Department of Education – Davao Region, and in coordination with the Department of Health – Davao Center for Health Development, this is to reiterate the implementation of minimum public health standards in all schools and offices to prevent the spread of Mpox (Monkeypox).
- 2. As the risk of Mpox continues to evolve, it is important that we remain vigilant in recognizing the common signs and symptoms and adopting the following preventive actions:

Minimum Public Health Standards to be Observed:

- A. **Practice good hand hygiene** Ensure access to handwashing facilities or hand sanitizers.
- B. Sanitize high-touch/frequently touched surfaces regularly.
- C. Monitor symptoms among learners and personnel.
- D. Avoid close contact with sick individuals.
- ${\mathbb E}.$ Quarantine or isolate individuals with suspected contagious diseases.
- F. Seek immediate medical consultation when symptoms arise.
- 3. In addition, all school heads and designated health personnel are instructed to conduct daily health monitoring and maintain updated records. Suspected, probable, or confirmed cases must be reported promptly to the District Nurses and Division Medical Section.

REGIONAL MEMORANDUM ESSD-2025-157

REITERATION OF THE PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR MPOX

To: Assistant Regional Director Schools Division Superintendents Chief Education Supervisors

- Attached is a letter from the Department of Health Davao Center for Health Development dated May 28, 2025, acknowledging the risks of Mpox in the Region and the need for the public to know the common signs and symptoms and its preventive measures.
- Anent to this, to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone especially during the resumption of classes, it is encouraged to follow these minimum public health standards for Mpox in the offices/schools for effective control and prevention:
 - a. Practice good hand hygiene ensuring access to handwashing facilities with soap or sanitizers;
 - b. Sanitizing frequently touched surfaces;
 - c. Monitoring symptoms;
 - d. Avoiding close contact with sick persons;
 - e. Quarantining/isolating person with contagious disease; and
 - f. Seeking immediate consultation.
- 3. Furthermore, this Office reiterates RM ESSD-2024-390 or the implementation of Project SHIELD (Strategic Health Intervention to Emerging health threats thru IEC for Learners and educators in Davao Region) in schools and Offices as its proactive countermeasures to notifiable diseases and health events. School heads and health personnel on-duty shall conduct daily monitoring of health status of learners and personnel, and maintain a record on health status through submission of reports to the Regional Office on suspected, probable, and confirmed cases of notifiable diseases through Google Sheets via https://bit.ly/SchoolDseSurv2k25-
- Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
