

The Operations Strand, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), is responsible for overseeing and managing the implementation of the School-Baseci Feeding Program (SBFP).

SBFP aims to improve the classroom attendance and nutritional status of the target beneficiaries. The provision of Hot Meals (HM) or Nutritious Food Products (NFP) and Milk to severely wasted and wasted learners are expected to contribute to the participate and benefit in the education process, complete their elementary education, and to improve their nutritional status. This School Year 2024-2025, SBFP transitioned to provide year-round, HM and/or NFP and milk.
