CONDUCT OF 2025 DIVISION SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (DSPC)

1. **Republic Act No. 7079**, also known as *Campus Journalism Act of 1991*, in its Declaration of Policy, stipulates that *“the State shall uphold and protect the freedom of the press even at the campus level and to promote the development and growth of campus journalism as a means of strengthening ethical values, encouraging critical and creative thinking, and developing moral character and personal discipline of the Filipino youth. In furtherance of this policy, the State shall undertake various programs and projects aimed at improving the journalistic skills of students concerned and promoting responsible and free journalism”*.
2. Pursuant also to DepEd Order (DO) No. 94, s. 1992 titled, *“Promulgating the Rules and Regulations Necessary for Effective Implementation of RA 7079”*, which stipulates the holding of the annual elementary and secondary schools press conferences, the Schools Division of Davao del Norte has been strengthening consistently its advocacy for press freedom throughout the years as demonstrated by its performances in the different levels of journalistic competitions and school paper publications.
3. Given the above-mentioned provisions, this Office hereby informs the field of the conduct of the **2025 Division Schools Press Conference** with the theme, **“Campus Journalism: A Driving Force towards Critical and Creative Thinking”**, at **Carmen National High School and Carmen Central Elementary School-SPED Center, Municipality of Carmen, Davao del Norte on January 24-28, 2025**.
4. The 2025 Division Schools Press Conference (DSPC) aims to attain the following objectives:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of journalism through skillful execution in various platforms (e.g., print, broadcast, and online);
 - b. recognize the role of journalism in advocating for social consciousness and environmental awareness;
 - c. promote fair and ethical use of media as tenets of responsible journalism;
 - d. foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through healthy and friendly competitions, and
 - e. provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers.

5. The conduct of the 2025 DSPC is aligned with the thrust of Republic Act (RA) no. 10533 known as the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013, wherein Section 2 of the said policy states that *“the State shall establish, maintain, and support a complete, adequate, and integrated system of education relevant to the needs of the people, the country, and society-at-large”*.
6. The official 2024 DSPC events to be contested for both Elementary and Secondary levels are the following:

Newswriting	Copy Reading and Headline Writing
Editorial Writing	Photojournalism
Feature Writing	Collaborative Desktop Publishing
Science and Technology Writing	Online Publishing (Secondary Only)
Sports Writing	Radio Broadcasting
Column Writing	TV Broadcasting (Secondary Only)
Editorial Cartooning	School Paper

7. Each district shall only send a maximum of 10 participants for each event in individual contests and a maximum of three groups for group events. A campus journalist is allowed to join only one event. There shall be **seven** members only per group for Collaborative Publishing, Radio Broadcasting, and TV Broadcasting. Online Publishing shall only have **five** members per group.
8. The field is advised to refer to DepEd Memorandum No. 25, s. 2024, titled *“2024 National Schools Press Conference”*, as the current guidelines for the 2025 DSPC Competitions.
9. Each school delegation shall submit their school paper (in two copies, A4 for elementary and long bond paper for Secondary) on/ or before January 22, 2024, at Carmen District CES-SC. There shall be a minimum of **12** pages (at least a minimum of two pages per section: *News Page, Editorial Page, Feature Page, Science and Technology Page, and Sports Page; Layout and Design* are included) and a maximum of **20** pages (four Pages for each section) in the school paper contest. School papers that could not reach the minimum number of pages will not be evaluated.
10. The schemes or phases of the contested events in 2025 DSPC are as follows:

Individual Events

Level	Scheme
Level 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Elimination for Top 50 (After the parade, all individual participants shall proceed immediately to contest venues for the first level of the competitions.)• Once the Top 50 CJs are identified, they shall join the first training session with the assigned evaluator.
Level 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Elimination for Top 25 (25 CJs shall be selected.)• The Top 25 CJs shall be trained more intensively by the assigned evaluator.
Level 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Elimination for Top 15 (15 CJs shall be selected.)• The Top 15 CJs shall be trained further for the third time by the assigned evaluator.
Level 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Top 15 CJs shall compete in the final round to determine the Top 7 winners of the contested DSPC event. Top 1 to 5

shall represent the Division to the 2024 RSPC. Top 6 and 7 shall be alternates, if there will be top 5 qualifiers who could not make it.

Group Events

Level	Scheme
Level 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Elimination for Top 5 (After the program all group event participants shall proceed immediately to contest venues for the first level of the competitions.)• Radio Broadcasting, Collaborative Publishing, and Online Publishing Participants shall be attending a press conference to gain inputs for their outputs (changes may happen depending on the instruction of the evaluator).• Once the Top 5 groups per event are identified, they shall join the first training session with the assigned evaluator.
Level 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Elimination for Top 2 (The Top 5 groups shall compete in the final round to determine their ranking in the contested DSPC event.• After the announcement of Top 2 Regional Qualifiers, Top 2 groups will still join the final training/inputting of the evaluators. Top 1 and Top 2 Groups shall represent the Division to the 2025 RSPC.

11. School Delegations are expected to arrive on Day 0 (January 23, 2024) with the following needed requirements: approved Travel Order, Parent's Consent, Medical Certificate, Official Receipt as registered participants, Identification Cards, beddings, personal hygiene kits, bathing paraphernalia, and other required gadgets, WiFi, laptops, cameras, extension wires, and the likes for individual and group events.
12. To emphasize, campus journalists as representatives to the 2025 DSPC bring honor to the school and district. Hence, they shall be credited with points in their academic subjects. Highest Possible Scores in written works, summative tests, and performance tasks in all subjects, so long graded, except for quarterly examinations shall be credited to CJs from practices/rehearsals, writing of school papers, to competition schedules. Submission of Major projects/requirements (ex. research/portfolio for immersion) shall be given an extension. Teachers shall give additional homework or exercises via blended learning or extension of the projects and requirements for CJs to cope with their academics and mental health.
13. This is to further emphasize that aside from Campus Journalists, all students who will participate in the trade/market/product display, Boy Scouts, performers, and other learners who have a part in the conduct of the 2025 DSPC shall be excused and be credited with points. Teachers shall consider the students' participation as part of their performance tasks. Teachers shall also give additional exercises via blended learning or extension of the projects and requirements for students to cope with their academics and health.
14. School participants are requested to register online starting December 23, 2024, through Maam Gerlyn C. Carpina, and to start paying the registration fees through Davao del Norte Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (DNESSPA) treasurers-Aileen S. Carungay for Elementary and Bernadeth Clarin for Secondary to avoid inconvenience during the proceedings of the 2025 DSPC.

15. There shall be an ocular inspection on January 16, 2024 (to be attended by Lights, Water, and Billeting Quarter Committees and available EPSs) at Carmen's host schools, billeting quarters, contest venues, and other areas to ensure preparedness for the event.
16. All committee chairpersons, co-chairpersons, members, proctors, facilitators, DDNESSPA Officers, and LGU counterparts shall join the final coordination meeting on January 17, 2025 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM at Municipality of Carmen, Davao del Norte.
17. In addition, there shall be a tech run/final rehearsal for all the performances of students and teachers who will perform in the 2025 DSPC opening program on January 23, 2025, at 9:00 AM at the venue, Carme District, Davao del Norte.
18. Furthermore, the following Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) and other personnel shall oversee and assist the Campus Journalism Focal Persons in ensuring a smooth conduct of 2025 DSPC:

19. There will be a registration of P250.00 per School Paper Adviser and P250.00 per campus journalist to defray expenses for membership fees, evaluators' professional fees, board and lodging, and travel expenses, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
20. Meals, travel expenses, and registration fees of the participants are chargeable against School MOOE/Campus Journalism Funds/PTA and other local sources of funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
21. Classes of the teachers/coaches who will attend the 2025 DSPC, intensive training, and conferences relative to the conduct and preparation of 2025 DSPC shall be arranged accordingly to avoid disruption of classes, adhering to the policy of "No disruption of classes, pursuant to the provision under DepEd Order (DO) 9 s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase/ Engaged Time on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith". **Host Schools (Carmen**

NHS and Carmen CES-SC) shall have online/modular classes and other billeting quarters may have blended learning to ensure that classes are going on for non-DSPC participants.

22. Service Credits shall be granted to the teacher participant (DepEd Order No. 53, s. 20023) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s 2004) for services rendered during weekends, and holidays.
