GENERAL GUIDELINES

- I. The National Linguistics Challenge is an online competition open to all students from Grade 3 to Grade 12 who are officially enrolled in schools across the Philippines for the school year 2024-2025. The competition aims to enhance and showcase the English language skills of participants, fostering a deeper understanding and mastery of linguistic concepts, grammar, vocabulary, and reading comprehension.
- II. A strong and stable internet connection is required during the competition.

III. FORMAT

There will be a 30-item multiple choice type of question good for 45 minutes.

IV. CATEGORY

Students are categorized based on their grade level for the school year 2024-2025. Only those officially enrolled in the Philippines are eligible to participate in the competition.

Level 1 - This category includes students enrolled in Grades 3 and 4 for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Level 2 - This category includes students enrolled in Grades 5 and 6 for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Level 3 - This category includes students enrolled in Grades 7 and 8 for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Level 4 - This category includes students enrolled in Grades 9 and 10 for the 2024-2025 academic year

Level 5 - This category includes students enrolled in Grades 11 and 12 for the 2024-2025 academic year

V. TOPICS COVERED

The topics covered in the program encompass several areas essential for language development and literacy.

Vocabulary includes lessons on synonyms, antonyms, context clues, and idiomatic expressions to enhance word knowledge and usage.





Language instruction focuses on subject-verb agreement, prepositions, conjunctions, conjunctive adverbs, verb tenses, the order of adjectives, proper use of punctuation, pronouns and their antecedents, parallelism or parallel structures, direct and reported speech, and figures of speech to build grammatical accuracy and stylistic effectiveness.

Reading comprehension skills are developed through activities on making inferences, identifying the main idea and supporting details, summarizing, and determining the tone and mood of passages.

Additionally, **spelling** is emphasized for Grades 3 and 4, helping young learners achieve accuracy in written communication.

VI. AWARDS

The awards committee will recognize the participants in this manner:

The top 30% of the participants per category will receive an e-Certificate of Recognition and medal.

Top 10% of the participants per category will be receiving a gold medal.

Top 11% - 20% of the participants per category will be receiving a silver medal.

Top 21% - 30% of the participants per category will be receiving a bronze medal.

Lower 70% of the participants shall receive either of the following:

Top 31% - 50% of the participants per category will be receiving an e-Achiever Certificate.

Top 51% - 75% of the participants per category will be receiving an e-Merit Certificate.

Top 76% - 100% of the participants per category will be receiving an e-Participation Certificate.

Winning Coach will be given a certificate of recognition as winning coach.
