INTENSIFICATION OF MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION IN TEACHING SPECIFIC LEARNING AREA

Attached herewith is Regional Memorandum CLMD-2023-031 reiterating DepEd Order No. 36, s. 2006 Implementing Rules and Regulations on Executive Order No. 210 also known as "Establishing the Policy to Strengthen the Use of English Language as a Medium of Instruction in the Education System".

The use of the Medium of Instruction should be intensified as follows:

- a. **ENGLISH** for the subjects English, Science, Mathematics, TLE and **FILIPINO** for the subjects in Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpakatao and MAPEH.
- b. The use of the **MOTHER TONGUE** as the language of instruction beginning in Grade 1 is now recognized as the *Most Effective* way to improve student learning and shall also serve as a strong bridge language to learn a second language better and faster.
- c. The *Mother Tongue* is likewise recommended as the language of Instruction for Basic Literacy in the Alternative Learning System (ALS).

INTENSIFICATION OF MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

IN TEACHING SPECIFIC LEARNING AREA

As stipulated to the DepEd Order No. 36, S. 2006 Implementing Rules and Regulations on Executive Order No.210 (Establishing the Policy to strengthen the use of the English Language as a Medium of Instruction in the Educational System) the teachers are advised to comply with the existing medium of Instruction per Learning Area,: Filipino and English which shall remain the languages of instruction.

Bilingual Education Policy and the local languages are to be used as auxiliary languages of instruction for formal education and for the alternative learning system.

The use of the stated medium of instruction should be intensified, to wit:

- a.) English for the subjects in English, Science, Mathematics, TLE and Filipino for the subjects in Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao
- b.) The use of the Mother Tongue as the language of instruction beginning in Grade 1 is now recognized as the most effective way to improve student learning and shall also serve as a strong bridge language to learn a second language
- c.) For the learners in the alternative learning system, the mother tongue is likewise recommended as the language of instruction for basic literacy.

Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
