The Teachers Dignity Coalition (TDC) will hold a *National Consultation-Training for Teachers* on April 29-May 1, 2023 at the Benitez Hall of Baguio Teachers' Camp. The activity will coincide with the organization's 5th National Convention and the celebration of its 17th Anniversary. The theme for the activity is "*Pagkakaisa at Pagmamalasakit Para sa Guro, Para sa Batu, Para sa Matatag na Edukasyon.*"

- Formulate policy recommendations in response to current issues and concerns.


Each participant shall be charged a minimal contribution/registration fee of four thousand two hundred pesos (P4,200.00) to cover expenses for board and lodging, kit, materials, speakers' honoraria, and other incidental expenses. We have sent a formal request to the DepEd to allow such expenses to be charged against available local funds. Pending the approval, however, our delegates also have the option to raise funds from private sponsorship of LGU assistance.
