SCHOOL-BASED IMMERSION OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL DURING PANDEMIC TIME

1. Relative to the requests of schools offering Senior High School to conduct a School-based Immersion activities to its TVL learners, the office advises the schools to adhere to the Regional Memorandum No. 045, s. 2021 entitled Ensuring Compliance with the Required Health and Safety Protocols in the Conduct of Senior High School Work Immersion Programs or Its DepEd Allowed Alternate Activities in the Face of COVID-19 Pandemic. Further, this office requires all Private and Public Schools implementing Immersion Programs to strictly comply with the health and safety protocols imposed by the Department of Health, the Department of Education, the Inter- Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Disease and the Office of the President in the implementation of work immersion activities or its alternate activities allowed by the Department of Education.
2. It is reminded that the Due Diligence as specified in Division Memorandum No. 470, s. 2021 be followed before allowing the learners to undergo the school- based Immersion. Clearance from the IATF must be secured as well by the school.
3. The Matrix of the school-based Immersion specifying the details of the activities, and the compliance with the Due Diligence must have to be checked by the Senior High School Focal Person and School Head before proceeding to the activity.
4. The Chief of the Curriculum Implementation Division, Public Schools District Supervisors and concerned Education Program Supervisors are tasked to monitor the compliance of the Private and Public Schools implementing Senior High School Immersion.
5. Attached is the list of schools requesting for school-based immersion, with the corresponding notations and requirements needed before proceeding to the school-based immersion under Alert Level 2.
6. Everyone is highly encouraged to continually support and recognize the value of equality and diversity of all personnel while complying with the directives set forth by this office.
