This has reference to the official communication from the Ministry of Education of Singapore regarding the invitation to participate in Academy of Singapore Teachers' Teacher Leader Programme 2 (TLP2) to be held on 28 February-4 March 2022 via online mode.

As part of a whole-of-MOE initiative titled "Knowing Asia" under the Ministry's Learn for Life thrust, the Ministry of Education of Singapore has been conducting professional development modules for Singapore teachers, school middle-management and school leaders to provide them more exposure to the region. In turn, they will be better equipped to plan internationalization programmes for their students. Participants of the TLP2 are Lead Teachers

whose responsibilities in schools are to develop the competencies of younger teachers.

The aim of the internationalization programme within the TLP2 is for participants to:

- Understand the broader context, both local and external, driving educational policies;
- Have opportunities to hear from and dialogue with overseas educators, and identify transferable learning points that can strengthen local classroom practices;
- Be equipped to support internationalization programmes for students in their schools.

Virtual Roundtable Discussion with Regional Teachers (3 March 2022, 9:15 - 11:30 AM Manila time)

MOE Singapore is also planning a virtual roundtable discussion between the TLP2 participants and teachers from the region. The organizers plan to have two teachers in each concurrent session on promoting creative and critical thinking. Participants will be able to select the topics that they are interested to learn more about in 6 concurrent sessions (2 sessions per topic), as follows:

- Developing/nurturing digital literacy
- Promoting creative and critical thinking
- Supporting students with Special Education Needs
