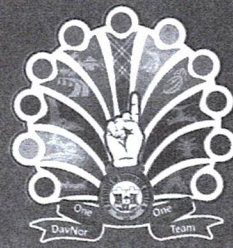

AN ORDER LAUNCHING THE OPLAN TABANG 2 PROGRAM (RESBAKUNA PLUS) OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF DAVAO DEL NORTE, CREATING FOR ITS COMMITTEES AND TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP (TWG), AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted to ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among its residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Davao del Norte, putting premium on *Health and Wellness* as its policy statement, aims to strengthen the delivery of basic services particularly Health and Social Services through convergence of various departments of the Provincial Government and stakeholders who shall complement their resources, services, and expertise in various areas of cooperation to bring the most essential government services much closer to the people in the barangays and local communities, especially those living in the Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDAS);

WHEREAS, the *OPLAN TABANG (TAPOK SA BARANGAY ALANG SA NANGINAHANGLAN UG GALISOD)* which was first launched in 2019 through Executive Order No. 06, series of 2019, is a multi-stakeholder and community-based convergence approach program aiming to deliver the programs and services of the Provincial Government and its partner-stakeholders much closer to all Dabaonons and the people living in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDAS) of the Province towards genuine change and holistic development;

WHEREAS, at the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, the National Government thru the Department of Health (DOH) launched the *RESBAKUNA: Kasangga ng Bida Campaign* as part of the roll-out of the National Vaccination Program, to encourage our constituents to get vaccinated to achieve our goal for herd immunity and to bring economic resurgence;

WHEREAS, the launching of the Oplan TABANG 2 is hoped to boost the efficiency of the RESBAKUNA Program by including other government essential services that include medical, legal, and other social services to help encourage unvaccinated populace, especially those living in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDAS) of the Province to get the jobs since they can also avail other services that they need;

WHEREAS, there is a need to create various Committees and Technical Working Group to take charge in the preparation and implementation of the Oplan TABANG 2 Program (Resbakuna Plus);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWIN I. JUBAHIB, Governor of the Province of Davao del Norte, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 4. Areas of Cooperation. The Provincial Government departments shall work together to bring the essential services to the GIDAS in full convergence of all stakeholders. They shall in any way extend their expertise and resources, complementing that of the frontline department to provide fully responsive and effective government services. Each Department can also tap the support of the corresponding National Government Agency for counterparts. This section is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 4.1 Resbakuna, Health & Social Services.** This refers to the COVID-19 vaccination service and other various medical and social welfare services that are not limited to the following; 1.) libreng lugaw and libreng gupit for the general public and tsinelas for preschoolers; 2.) advocacy on social welfare programs; 3.) provision of wheelchair/assistive devices; 4.) free dental and medical consultations; 5.) minor surgical operations; 6.) IEC for public awareness, viz. TB seminar/screening; family planning, nutrition seminar etc.;
- 4.2 Legal Services.** This refers to the civil legal aid extended to the public in the form of free legal advices and law interpretations, and notarial services for contracts and agreements, affidavits, and petition for clerical errors;
- 4.3 Crops and Fisheries.** This refers to the various agricultural programs and services that are not limited to the following: 1.) fingerlings distribution; 2.) seed dispersal; 3.) farm management seminars/techno-clinic; and 4.) KAAGAPAY program orientation;
- 4.4 Animal Health & Livestock.** This refers to the various veterinary services that are not limited to the following: 1.) free anti-rabies vaccination 2.) free vitamins for various animals 3.) animal check-ups & livestock dispersal; 4.) animal advocacy seminars;

- 4.5 **Disaster Awareness and Preparedness.** This refers to any programs of PDRRMD that aim to raise the awareness and readiness of the public in the barangay level such as 1.) orientation on disaster preparedness; 2.) fire and earthquake drill; 3.) free grab/first-aid kits;
- 4.6 **Roads and Infrastructures.** This refers to the various engineering services relevant to enhancing the accessibility and conditions of roads and bridges in the barangay and providing technical assistance to the barangay to improve its capacity on techniques for M and E of project outcomes and impacts; this also refers to events to be conducted by the PEO such as groundbreaking and blessing and inauguration of projects;
- 4.7 **Physical Preparation.** This refers to the physical preparation of the venue, facilities and other equipment to be used during the conduct of Oplan TABANG;
- 4.8 **Environmental & Peace Education.** This refers to the various programs for the protection of our environment and natural resources which are not limited to the following: 1.) BASURESIKLO; 2.) garbage and waste segregation; 3.) tree planting; 4.) peace education; 5.) seedling distribution (fruits and forest trees);
- 4.9 **Livelihood Opportunities.** This refers to the various programs that aim to provide livelihood opportunities to residents and cooperatives in the barangay depending on their growth potential by conducting capacity development trainings and seminars for developing products as source of livelihood;
- 4.10 **Documentation and Program.** This refers to the services provided to document the activity either on document, online, or media; and to plan and organize the flow of the activities;
- 4.11 **Security and other services.** This refers to the services provided prior and during the conduct of the Oplan TABANG safety of the public and the surrounding premises which the AFP and PNP shall be on top. Peace and order shall be ensured in crowd management.

Section 5. Responsibilities of the Secretariat. The Secretariat shall be responsible of the following:

- 5.1 Formulation/ Drafting of a Program Design for the Oplan TABANG Program;
- 5.2 Formulation of a two-month schedule of the Oplan TABANG Program to be conducted once in every LGU with two (2) clusters per LGU per day covering most of the LGU's barangays;
- 5.3 Coordination with the officials of the barangays and LGU's concerned in coordination with DILG;
- 5.4 Generate Report of the Accomplishments of the Oplan TABANG Program in coordination with the Provincial Information, Communication and Knowledge Management Office and Provincial Administrator's Office - Information Technology Division; and
- 5.5 Perform other tasks as may be requested by the Governor.

Section 6. Responsibilities of the City/Municipal Mayors. The concerned City/Municipal Mayors shall be responsible of the following:

- 6.1 Closely work together with the barangay in the preparation of the activity;

6.2 Assist in the information dissemination to ensure widest participation of the public;

6.3 Provide assistance in the preparation of food for the working committees; and

6.4 Extend other services within their capacity as maybe requested by the organizers.

Section 7. Responsibilities of the Barangay. The concerned barangay shall be responsible of the following:

7.1 Coordinate with other barangays in the cluster to ensure the success of the activity;

7.2 Assist in the information dissemination to ensure widest participation of the public;

7.3 Supervise the preparation of food for the working committees;

7.4 Assist in ensuring that all materials, properties, paraphernalia used during the activity are all accounted for; and

7.5 Extend other services within their capacity as maybe requested by the organizers.

Section 8. Responsibilities of the Department of Education. The Department of Education shall be responsible of the following:


8.1 In the event that the Oplan TABANG will be conducted inside the school, proper coordination must be ensured with the barangay and the principal of the school for the necessary arrangements to be done for the activity; and

8.2 Extend other services within their capacity as maybe requested by the organizers.

Section 9. Funding. The budgetary requirements for the conduct of the activities of the Oplan TABANG shall be sourced from the budget of respective department Programs/ Projects/ Activities (PPAs) and Anti-Crime and Development Integration Project, Supplemental Budget No. 1.

Section 10. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof and shall remain in force unless revoked or rescinded.
