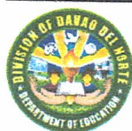
**ADMINISTRATION OF THE NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST FOR GRADE 10
 (NATG10) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023**

1. Pursuant to **Deped Order No. 034, s. 2022** titled as **School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023**, the **National Achievement Test for Grade 10 (NATG10)** shall be administered on **June 27, 2023** in all public and private junior high schools.
2. Private Schools, that already conducted their End of School Year (EOSY) Rites or are set to conduct their EOSY Rites before June 27, 2023, are no longer included in the said NATG10.
3. In line with this, there will be an **Orientation on the NATG10 Administration on June 14, 2023 at 8:00 a.m. at Asuncion National High School**, Asuncion, Davao del Norte. The **school testing coordinators** in all public and private junior high schools offering Grade 10 are the participants to the said Orientation. The participants shall prepare and bring laptops, extension wires, and the list and data (see template below) of bonafide Grade 10 learners (in Excel Format) for the sampling of test-takers.

4. Meanwhile, classes of teachers who shall attend/ participate in the NATG10 Orientation and Administration shall be arranged accordingly to avoid disruption of classes, in adherence to the policy of *"No disruption of classes, pursuant to the provision under DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith"*.
5. Travel, meals and other incidental expenses incurred in the activity of participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



6. It is emphasized that everyone shall observe and follow the minimum health protocols in accordance with the Inter-Agency Task Force Against Infectious Disease (IATF) and Department of Health (DOH) rules and guidelines, while the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) must always be upheld.
7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance to this memorandum are directed.
