

# REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6380

AN ACT DECLARING JULY FIRST OF EACH YEAR AS A PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCES OF DAVAO ORIENTAL, DAVAO DEL SUR, AND DAVAO DEL NORTE
