DIVISION IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP 2023

1. Relative to the Department of Education (DepEd) National Learning Recovery Program (NLRP) implementation, and in line with the MATATAG Agenda Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa, DepEd Davao del Norte supports the implementation of the National Learning Camp (NLC) and other End-Of-School Year (EOSY) Break Activities that have been initiated and to be conducted from July 24, 2023 to August 25, 2023. Its phased implementation in 2022-2023 EOSY break shall start with Grade 7 and 8 in English, Science and Mathematics for Enhancement, Consolidation and Intervention Camps. However, Grades 9 to 11 learners may opt to conduct EOSY activities to address the least mastered competencies in the learning areas in English, Science and Mathematics. This National Learning Camp is VOLUNTARY in nature.
2. For the Elementary level, the results of the CRLA and PHIL IRI shall be the basis for the K-3 learners whose focus is the Literacy and Numeracy skills while in grades 4 to 6, the results of the Least-Mastered Competencies in the Regional Achievement Test (RAT) and the Final Average Grades of the learners shall be the basis in categorizing in the different camps such as: Intervention, Consolidation and Enhancement Camps respectively. For the Remedial Classes are intended for those learners who failed in 1 or 2 learning areas. The camp shall commence on July 24, 2023 and will end on August 11, 2023. Please refer to the attached regional memorandum for the suggested activities and class program of the camps.
3. Teachers who will serve the Learning Camp shall be granted vacation leave credits equivalent to the number of days served during the duration of the camp as per provisions stipulated in DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003, and other incentives, chargeable against the downloaded Program Support Funds of the National Learning Camp.

Subject: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REGIONAL LEARNING CAMP

Date : July 7, 2023

The Department of Education (DepEd), as articulated in MATATAG: Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa agenda, has committed to a learning recovery program to address learning losses arising from, among others, the COVID-19 pandemic. The Department of Education initiated National Learning Camp as part of the learning recovery program which aims to help the students catch up with learning losses and strengthen teacher competence to teach effectively.

DepEd Region XI initiated the Regional Achievement Test (RAT) as mechanism to measure learners learning losses. To address the least mastered competencies in the learning areas of English, Mathematics and Science, Regional Learning Camp serves as avenue to address such losses.

The Regional Learning Camp will start on July 24 – August 11, 2023 and will be implemented daily for 3 weeks. It focuses on Literacy, Numeracy and Science Exploration addressing the least mastered competencies as a result of the Regional Achievement Test (RAT), categorizing in different camps:

- Intervention Camp - Designed to support learners who are yet to grasp fundamental literacy and/or numeracy skill. Frustration Reading Level in the Phil-IRL.
- Enhancement Camp - Provide further practice and application of Grade-level learning competencies; Instructional Reading Level in the Phil-IRL.
- Consolidated Camp - For advance learners by providing greater depth, breadth and complexity of learning area competencies; Independent Reading Level in the Phil-IRL.
- Remedial Class for those learners who failed in 1 or 2 learning areas.

It is encouraged that Schools Division Offices will invite volunteers such as: DOST Scholars, retired teachers, parents, private school teachers/professors, education graduates and students, barangay workers, etc. to highlight the spirit of Filipino Bayanihan.

The Terms of Reference in the implementation of the Regional Learning Camp (RLC) is attached in the Enclosure A.





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Schools Division Offices and schools are given freeway on how the Regional Learning Camp will be established. All concerned are required to create an online link for the weekly reporting of activities using the template provided in Enclosure B: Division/School Learning Camp Monitoring and Tracking Tool. Access to this link shall be provided to RO RLC Team for monitoring, provision of technical assistance and follow – up.

The Regional Office shall likewise create an online link for the weekly reporting using the Regional Learning Camp Monitoring and Tracking Tool Template in Enclosure B.

Further, it is encouraged that schools shall conduct parents' orientation on the core values of teaching and learning, making learning an enjoyable and challenging experience by ensuring teaching techniques responsive to the needs of their children and make learning opportunities appropriate to competencies to be learned.

All expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged to MOOE/Local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Immediate dissemination of and compliance to this Memorandum to all concerned is directed.

**Terms and Reference on the Implementation of
 the Regional Learning Camp**

The Regional Learning Camp shall handle these areas of concerns and other matters:

1. Information and Guidance on Learning Camp;
2. Provisions of learning resources which will address the identified least mastered competencies;
3. Learner's learning performance using Daily Journal which the teacher will write the strength and needs to be improved by the learner;
4. Conduct of Parent's Orientation and requires parents; consent;
5. Teacher's Training;
6. Health and safety protocols;
7. Stakeholders' engagement and support; and
8. All other matters related to curriculum and learning.

I. Timeline:

1. Early registration shall be conducted at least two weeks before the end of the school year. Official registration shall be conducted for two weeks from July 1, 2023 to July 14, 2023. Under the supervision and guidance of their school heads, class advisers shall be responsible for enlisting interested learners.
2. Learning Camp implementation July 24, 2023 to August 11, 2023.
3. August 12, 2023 Culmination Day of the Learning Camp

- Teachers who will participate in the learning camp shall be given service credits and certificate of appreciation for the rendered services;
- If teachers prefer to serve in the school near to their residences, school head will allow them provided that signed DTR will be presented after the learning camp implementation;
- Comply daily Journal of the learners listing all the strength and needs to be improved by the learners for intervention program.

Subject: IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL LEARNING CAMP

Date : July 7, 2023

Relative to the Department of Education (DepEd) National Learning Recovery Program (NLRP) and in line with MATATAG Agenda *Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa*, the National Learning Camp (NLC) and other End-Of-School Year Break Activities have been initiated and to be conducted from July 24 to August 25, 2023. Its phased implementation in 2022-2023 EOSY break shall start with Grade 7 and 8 in English, Science, and Mathematics (ESM) for Enhancement, Consolidation, and Intervention Camps.

In this vein, this Office advises the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) to implement the NLC for Grades 7 and 8 and to conduct EOSY break activities such as remediation/remedial classes and enrichment activities in other grade levels to support learning recovery.

This Office also advises the SDOs to conduct the EOSY Reading Program for Kindergarten, Grade 1, and Grade 2 learners who underwent the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) and the EOSY Mathematics Program for Grades 1 to 3 learners and to take the Mathematics Rapid Assessment to be given by the Central Office.

Since the NLC and other EOSY Break Activities entail the services of teachers beyond the regular school days, incentives will be given to them as provided in DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2023 on the Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the National Learning Camp.

Reproduction of Teaching and Learning Materials for Grades 7 and 8 for ESM, and for K to 3 EOSY Reading and Mathematics Programs will be managed by the Regional Office. However, if in case the number of copies to be provided will not be enough to the number of learners joining the NLC, the SDOs are advised to supplement the needed materials.

A Program Support Fund will be given to the SDOs. It is advised to give prioritization to the needs and requirements of the Grades 7 and 8 teachers for the capacity building, meal expense, and for the teaching and learning materials.





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Details on the implementation of the NLC are found in the enclosures.

Expenses relative to the conduct of the NLC and other EO SY Break Activities shall be charged to Program Support Funds (PSFs) downloaded to the SDOs and to other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
