- 1. Pursuant to RA No. 7079, also known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, and as part of the conduct 2025 Division Schools Press Conference on November 02 (Day 0) to November 7, 2025 at Dujali Central Elementary School and Dujali National High School, Dujali District, Davao del Norte, this Office hereby informs the field of the Search of the Division's Outstanding School Paper Adviser (SPAs) and Outstanding Campus Journalist (CJs) for both elementary and secondary level.
- 2. Each district shall have only one entry for every category (Outstanding SPA-Elementary, Outstanding SPA-Secondary, Outstanding CJ-Elementary, and Outstanding CJ-Secondary) based on the criteria (provided by the region). Attached are the Basic Qualifications and Criteria for the Search (panel interview is excluded in the Division level).
- 3. Candidates shall be ranked based on the total points garnered. The top three (3) shall be given the following equivalent points, for consideration in the computation of the overall standing of the District, to wit: 1st place -5 points, 2nd place -3 points, and 3rd place-1 point.
- 4. The Selection Committee shall be composed of the Chairperson-Curriculum Implementation Chief (CID)-Chief, Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) for Campus Journalism, Senior Education Program Specialist (SEPS) for the Human Resource Development, and the President of the General Officers for the Davao del Norte Elementary and Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (DNESSPA) as needed.
- 5. The deadline for the submission of the portfolio or pertinent documents will be on October 30, 2025 (Thursday on or before 12:00 NN) at the CID office c/o Dr. Exelsis Deo A. Deloy-EPS. Selection Committee shall also convene on this day at 1:00 PM to evaluate and select the winners.
