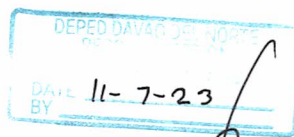

Relative to Regional Memorandum CLMD 2023-698 entitled Guidance on the Emergency Transfer of Learners Affected by the Israeli- Palestinian Conflict to Philippine Basic Education Institutions, this Office informs the field to admit affected learners as emergency transfer even with the unavailability of insufficiency of required transfer credentials. Herewith is the Memorandum OUOPS No.2023-01-9879 from Atty. Revsee A. Escobido, Undersecretary for Operations, and ASec. Francis Cesar B. Bringas, Assistant Secretary for Operations, DepED Central Office, regarding the Guidelines on the Emergency Transfer of Learners Affected by the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict to the Basic Education Institutions in the Philippines.

Anent to this, public schools in Region XI are instructed to admit affected learners as emergency transferees, even with the unavailability or insufficiency of required transfer credentials. Once the conflict subsides, the receiving school, shall make necessary coordination through the Schools Division Office to facilitate transfer of school records of the learner from the originating school.

Division Offices shall monitor and report the list of emergency transferees accepted in their respective jurisdictions to the Regional Office for consolidation and subsequent submission to the Central Office.

Furthermore, all concerned shall ensure the strict implementation of the DepEd's "No Collection Policy" in relation to the transfer of displaced learners to the public schools

SUBJECT : **Guidance on the Emergency Transfer of Learners Affected by the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict to Philippine Basic Education Institutions**

DATE : October 23, 2023

This is in reference to the ongoing conflict between Israel and Palestinian Militant Group Hamas, which led to the widescale destruction of key facilities and properties as well as casualties and injuries to civilians.

In anticipation of the repatriation of overseas Filipino workers and their families from Gaza City due to the Department of Foreign Affairs' declaration of crisis Alert Level 4 in the area, this Office issues the following guidelines on the emergency transfer of affected learners to basic education institutions in the Philippines.

All displaced learners who intend to transfer to any public schools in the country **shall be admitted as emergency transferees, even with the unavailability or insufficiency of required transfer credentials.** Once the conflict subsides, the receiving school, through its Schools Division Office, shall coordinate with the originating school for the transfer of school records of the learner.

The Division Offices shall monitor and report the list of emergency transferees accepted in their respective jurisdictions, to be submitted to their Regional Offices for consolidation. The consolidated list shall subsequently be submitted to the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations through email at oure@deped.gov.ph.

Furthermore, all concerned shall ensure the strict implementation of the DepEd's "No Collection Policy" in relation to the transfer of displaced learners to the public schools.
