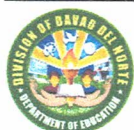
**SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IMMERSION OF TANGLAW AND STO. NINO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOLS**

This office advises as well to adhere to the Regional Memorandum No. 045, s. 2021 entitled Ensuring Compliance with the Required Health and Safety Protocols in the Conduct of Senior High School Work Immersion Programs or Its DepEd Allowed Alternate Activities in the Face of COVID-19 Pandemic, this office requires all Private



and Public Schools implementing Immersion Programs to strictly comply the health and safety protocols imposed by the Department of Health, the Department of Education, the Inter- Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Disease and the Office of the President in the implementation of work immersion activities or its alternate activities allowed by the Department of Education.

3. It is reminded that the Due Diligence as specified in Division Memorandum No. 470, s. 2021 be followed before allowing the learners to undergo the school- based Immersion. Clearance from the IATF must be secured as well by the school.
4. The Matrix of the school-based Immersion specifying the details of the activities, and the compliance of the Due Diligence must have to be checked by the Senior High School Focal Person, and School Head before proceeding to the activity.
5. The Chief of the CID, Public School District Supervisor and concerned Education Program Supervisors are tasked to monitor the compliance of the Private and Public Schools implementing Senior High School Immersion.
6. Everyone is highly encouraged to continually support and recognize the value of equality and diversity of all personnel while complying with the directives set forth by this office.
