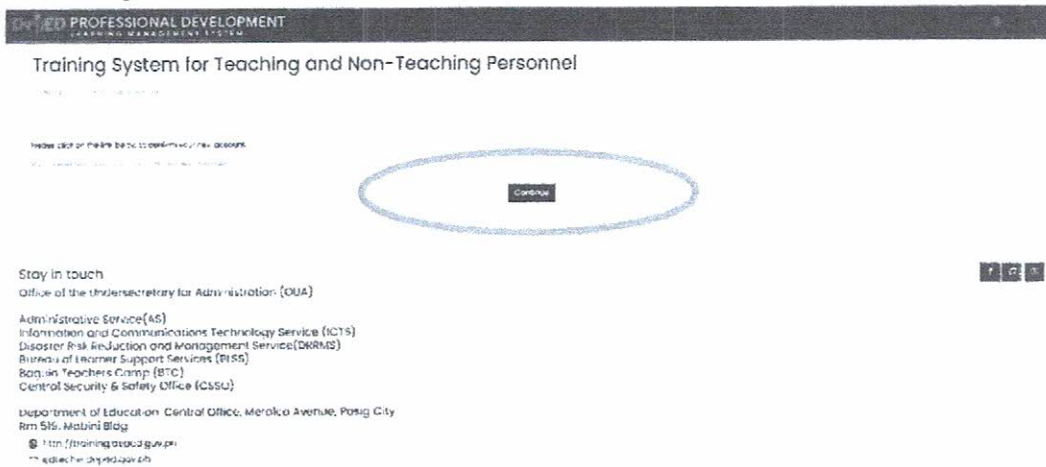
### Steps for Interested Participants without DepEd Email Accounts

3. Enter your **personal details** then click **Create my new account** tab.

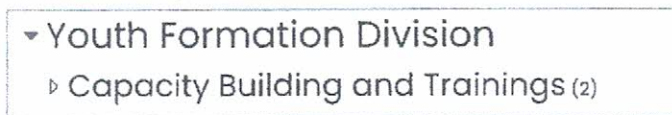
4. Confirm your account by clicking the **Continue** tab.



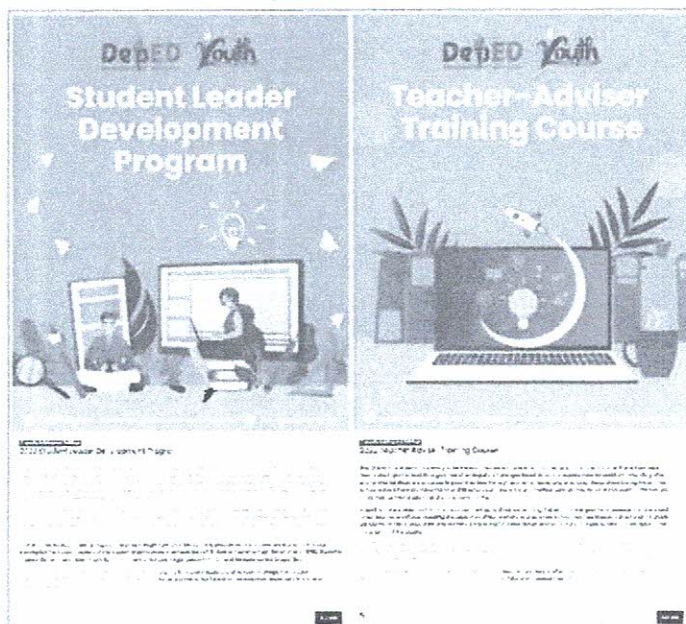
5. Fill-out the remaining details to complete your profile.
