

This is in relation to the Balik-Probinsya, Bagong Pag-Asa (BP2) Program of the national government which provides mechanisms for allowing families to go back to their respective provinces. As one of the agencies that play a role in facilitating the transfer of teachers and learners from their current station to where they will settle, all Schools Division Superintendents (SDS) of receiving Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are requested to:

1. Facilitate the transfer of teachers following the existing guidelines;
2. Accept the transfer of learners upon showing of the required documents to the receiving school;
3. Facilitate the transfer of learners in the Learner Information System (LIS); and
4. Provide orientation and onboarding intervention to learners.

Kindly refer to the attachment for the updated list of Teacher and Learner Beneficiaries for the April 2022 Dispatch Operations. Please also be reminded to prioritize and ensure the effective and efficient implementation of the said program.
