Greetings!

Drug abuse prevention efforts are most successful when fully coordinated through a multisectoral approach among government agencies and government offices, local government units along with the academe, and non-government organizations.

Very recently, the Provincial Anti-Drug Abuse Council (PADAC) has approved Resolution No. 02, s. 2021 "Approving and Adopting the Strong Families Program" as a Drug Abuse Prevention Program for children and youth of Davao del Norte.

The Strong Families modules originated from UNODC Philippines aimed to support the Filipino families who are at the threshold and are very much vulnerable from illegal drugs.
