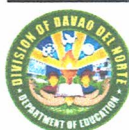

Greetings of hope!

Based on the Young Adult Fertility and Sexuality Study (YAFS-4), Davao Region ranked 3rd in the Philippines with the most number of youth who thought of committing suicide. In Davao del Norte, we also received reports of youth suicide deaths during the pandemic, the youngest of which is an 8-year old female child. On top of that, in 2021, Davao del Norte reported a total of 2,423 teenage pregnancies, 108 of which are 15 years old below.

To answer these pressing concerns, we will be launching a Provincial Adolescent – Friendly Health Facility and we are now working through the Level 1 and 2 requirements set by the Department of Health standards. The "DavNor Teen Tambayan Hub" is located at Door 8 of the Davao del Norte Sports and Tourism Complex, Mankilam, Tagum City. Moreover, the Executive Order on the Creation of the DavNor Teen Tambayan Hub Team has been recently approved by Governor Edwin I. Jubahib on which we have included your office/agency as member of the said provincial team.


