- 1. The month of July is National Disaster Resilience Month pursuant to Executive Order No. 39, s. 2017 which highlights shift of focus from disaster awareness building to disaster resilience.

1. REFERENCE:

- a. NDRRMC Memorandum on the Observance of the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) 2022.
- Executive Order Number 29 s 2017 designates July of each year as the National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) throughout the country and mandates the conduct of activities relative to building of disaster resilience covering the four thematic areas: prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, and rehabilitation and recovery,
- 3. The observance emphasizes the importance of strengthening and unifying the disaster risk reduction activities by leveraging on the participation of the general public and the National Government Agencies, Local Government Units, public and private sector employees, and Civil Society Organizations in transitioning to better new normal and preparation for new emerging disasters. Likewise, proposed activities for the observance are aligned and in adherence to the COVID-19 risk mitigation measures relative to the current IATF protocols. Also, the month of July marks the start of the wet or typhoon season highlighting the need to prepare for the same.
- 4. This year, the NDRM is marked with the theme "Sambayanang Pilipino, Nagkakaisa tungo sa Katatagan at Maunlad na Kinabukasan" to emphasize the importance of collaboration of all Filipinos to overcome the challenges of this pandemic and prepare ourselves for new emerging disasters toward building a safer, adaptive, and resilient future.
- 5. In this regard, all member agencies of the national, regional, and local DRRM Councils are hereby enjoined to observe the NDRM this July 2022 through the conduct of activities relative to disaster resilience, and to participate and promote the following NDRRMC and RDRRMC XI activities:
