4. Attendance of the participants shall be on Official Business). All participants must be fully vaccinated. They must present negative antigen results taken within 48 hours before their arrival at BTC.
5. There will be a registration fee amounting to Php5,500.00 for each participant, which shall cover the participant's board and lodging and seminar kits.
6. The travel expenses (transportation and per diem), registration fee, and other allowable fees of the participants shall be charged to local funds, regional/division MOOE, PTA/PTCA funds, local school board funds, and other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. To register, participants are required to pay the registration fee through the channels found in the enclosures. After payment, participants must register through bit.ly/PW-2022 and upload a copy of the deposit slip/print screen of online payment to complete the registration process.
8. The participants are welcome to join without discrimination against their age, sexual orientation and gender identity, religion, ethnicity, social status, income, class, political affiliation or other similar factors/ personal circumstances.
9. It is also emphasized that everyone shall observe and follow the minimum health protocols wherever they may be in accordance with the IATF and DOH rules and guidelines.
