**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND REMINDERS RELATIVE TO 2022
SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL SUMMIT CUM CAREER GUIDANCE**

1. Relative to the 2022 Senior High School Summit Cum Career Guidance on July 27-28, 2022, at Tagum City Atrium, this office informs the field on the following additional information, to wit:
 - a. The LGU officials, particularly the Mayor or Education Committee Chair, PTA Presidents or representatives and Barangay Captains or Barangay representatives are invited to visit the Summit. The PSDSs and school heads concerned are in-charge of the invitation, as well as the ushering of the guests during the visit of the above-mentioned stakeholders.
 - b. Since there is no allocation of food during the entire event, the participants are requested to bring their own "baon".
2. Be reminded as well that Parent's Consent shall be secured for those Grade 10, 11 and 12 learners, who shall be attending the Senior High School Summit onsite. The school heads, school coordinators, and teachers are in-charge to facilitate this requirement. Only the vaccinated participants are allowed to enter the Atrium Hall, Tagum City.
3. Furthermore, the artists/ designers/ IT officers, and teachers assigned for the display and other outputs are in-charge of the Restoration on



28 and 29, 2022. They shall also be entitled to service credits, according to the time spent, as per DO 53, s. 2003.

4. Everyone is highly encouraged to continually support and recognize the value of equality and diversity of all personnel while complying with the directives set forth by this office.
