3. However, the teacher-participants shall arrange their classes with the school heads. Schedule of classes with the signature of those teachers who will handle the latter in the absence of the DAME Chorale members shall be attached in their respective Authority to Travel for approval. This is in adherence to the policy on **“No Disruption of Classes”** per DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled: “Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and ensuring Compliance Therewith.
4. Likewise, this office identified non-teaching participants including the two (2) chiefs, Education Program Supervisors, and District Supervisors to join the 1000 voices and sing the Doxology (Then Sings My Souls) and Finale (Hallelujah Chorus). The link of those recorded video/songs plus lyrics will be sent through the FB Messenger Group Chat.
5. The updated list of the DAME Chorale members and non-teaching personnel is enclosed in this memorandum.
6. Teacher-participants including the supervisor are eligible for service credits/COCs depending on the accumulated number of hours rendered in the activity, which will fall on Holiday, Saturday, and Sunday based on DepEd Order (DO) No. 053, s. 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Service Credits to Teachers, and Do No. 084, s. 2003 entitled Addendum to DO No. 053, s. 2003, and CSC & DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004, “Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime for Overtime Services Rendered.
7. Travel expenses of the participants will be charged against local funds.
8. The participants are required to strictly observe the health protocols as prescribed by the IATF during this time of pandemic.
9. In the conduct of this activity, it is expected the Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) Performance goals and requirements must be observed in such a way to recognize universal equality of individuals regardless of gender, religion, ethnicity, and political affiliation.
