To address the recurring issues in the implementation of Multigrade Program, the Division of Davao del Norte continuously strengthens the implementation of the Multigrade Program through conducting series of trainings and monitoring. It has been deemed that it plays a significant role in improving the quality of educational services and learning outcomes of learners especially in the MG schools located in remote areas of the division.

In line with this, the Division of Davao del Norte through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) shall conduct a face to face Division Orientation on Multigrade Program on August 9-10, 2022. Venue will be announced later.
