MECHANICS & CRITERIA FOR JUDGING: 2022 DAVAO REGION SDG CHAMPION AWARD

I. RATIONALE

In, 2015, the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) were adopted by all UN member states as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure that all people enjoy peace and prosperity by the year 2030.



Since the Philippines' adoption of the SDGs, many initiatives have been undertaken by Davao Region in response and support to the realization of its objectives. The NEDA XI, through the Regional Development Council (RDC) XI as Davao Region's main mechanism for regional coordination on SDGs, initiates this "SDG Fiesta" advocacy event which aims to provide an avenue for discourse and knowledge sharing of the good practices, success stories, and lessons learned in the SDG implementation in Davao Region.

The highlight of this year's Davao Region SDG Fiesta is the awarding of the Davao Region 2022 SDG Champion Award. The Award shall be given to deserving

LGUs/offices/organizations who have exhibited exemplary implementation and best practices towards the realization of the Filipinos' collective commitments towards the SDGs.

The Davao Region 2022 SDG Champion Award shall be awarded in 3 distinct categories: the LGU Category; Academe & Schools Category; and the GOCCs/NGAs/Water Districts Category.

II. ELIGIBILITY

Provided in the matrix below are the eligibility criteria set for the 2022 Davao Region SDG Champion Award. The National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) XI and Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) XI are prohibited from submitting entries to the award.

Category	Eligibility Requirements
LGU Category	All Davao Region: (1) Provincial Local Governments, (2) Municipal Local Governments, (3) City Local Government Units, and (4) Highly Urbanized City (Davao City)
Academe & Schools Category	All Davao Region: (1) State Universities and Colleges (2) Higher Education Institutions duly recognized by CHED (3) Public or private schools duly recognized by DepEd (4) Technical or vocational institutions duly recognized by TESDA (5) Civil Society Groups or Private organizations operating as academic institutions or directly involved in the education sector of Davao Region.
GOCCs/NGAs/Water Districts Category	All government entities or instrumentalities operating within or for Davao Region.

IV. MECHANICS

- Participants must fill out and follow the steps specified in the online entry form for the Award, accessible via the link https://tinyurl.com/r11sdqchampion.
 The participants are ultimately required to prepare the following:
 - a. An AVP showcasing their PAPs (programs, activities, projects), best practices, and achievements relative to the SDGs.
 - Duly accomplished SDG Fiesta Forms indicating technical details, and documentation of the participants' SDG initiatives/accomplishments.

AVP Guidelines:

- The AVP shall be guided by the following general guidelines:
 - a. The AVP shall be limited to 3 to 7 minutes only.
 - The AVP must highlight the participant's profile and best practices, implementation, monitoring, and documentation of SDG initiatives.
 - Subtitles and closed captions should be provided in the AVP.

SDG Forms:

- Together with the AVP, the proponents must submit the following duly accomplished forms:
 - SDG Form 1 (SDG-Responsive Program, Activities and Projects)
 - II. SDG Form 2 (Documentation, Photos, and Data Tables, etc.)
