

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
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

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General Guidelines:

1. Participants joining the competition shall abide by the code of honesty and integrity.
2. Any form of cheating or dishonesty shall mean disqualification from the competition.
3. The participants shall keep their cameras open during the entire competition.
4. The participants shall ensure that the area where they are doing the competition will just have a table and a chair away from any other fixtures. This will be checked prior to the start of the competition.
5. Any form of coaching shall not be allowed.
6. The participants shall use the appropriate technical devices (laptop and desktop) as prescribed by the organizing committee.
7. The use of tablets and smartphones shall not be allowed.
8. A strong and stable internet connection (at least 50mbps) is required and shall be established prior to the start of the competition.
9. In cases where the internet connection becomes unstable or the devices become unavailable, the participants will be scored based on the scores generated by the platform use.
10. If the participants are disconnected for more than 5 minutes, the participants will be disqualified.
11. Participants should wear their school uniform and the background should be plain. Virtual backgrounds are not allowed.
12. The decision of the judges and the organizing committee is deemed final.

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Student Academic Olympiad Guidelines (both Middle School and Tertiary Category)

I. First Elimination Round (First Round): (For all Contestants)

1. The number of contestants will depend on the number of students who complete the registration.
2. There shall be 30 questions and shall be answered in 30 minutes. The type of questions will be multiple choice. The Secretariat will send a link of questions to contestants 2 minutes before the start for the Elimination Round (First Round).
3. The Top 30 Contestants shall qualify for the second round, based on the scores.
4. In case of the tie at the end of the round, Contestants with the same scores shall be asked to answer 2 Questions via Oral round on Zoom to break the tie.

II. Second Elimination Round: (30 Contestants)

1. The second round will include 10 Oral Questions from the organizing institution.
2. Each contestant must prepare a portable whiteboard and whiteboard marker (or a white paper and black marker) to write their answer and present it on their camera.
3. Each contestant will be given one (1) minute to answer each question.
4. Participants must not change their answers once they have presented their answers on camera. Failure to present their answers on time will result in nullification of answers for the specific question.
5. In case of the tie at the end of the round, Contestants with the same scores shall be asked to answer more questions until one student will get a point higher than the other student.
6. The Top 10 Contestants shall qualify for the final round based on the scores.

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III. Final Round: (10 Contestants)

1. The second round will include 10 Oral Questions from the organizing institution.
2. Each contestant must prepare a portable whiteboard and whiteboard marker (or a white paper and black marker) to write their answer and present it on their camera.
3. Each contestant will be given one (1) minute to answer each question.
4. Participants must not change their answers once they have presented their answers on camera. Failure to present their answers on time will result in nullification of answers for the specific question.
5. In case of the tie at the end of the round, Contestants with the same scores shall be asked to answer more questions until one student will get a point higher than the other student.
6. The Top 3 (Third placer, Second placer, and First placer) will be announced based on their scores.

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
