Greetings of peace and prosperity!

The Department of Education (DepEd) recognizes the importance of community and stakeholders especially in promoting quality and relevant education. In line with this, Gupitan Integrated School aims to continuously maintain a well-founded relationship between the community and stakeholders by involving them in crafting plans and programs that will hone the students' skills and produce competent graduates, thereby ensuring a better future. One among the significant suggestions from both the community and stakeholders is the opening of an additional Track in Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL) for the Senior High School Program.

Gupitan Integrated School has been offering Senior High School specifically General Academic Strand since 2019. It has promoted good impact especially to the students in the hinterland areas who aspire to pursue their education. After a few years of its operation, it has been identified that a solitary Senior High School Track does not suffice the need of the students. In a consultation between the school and various stakeholders, it was made known that there are students who want to acquire life skills such as but not limited to organic agriculture production and other agricultural related courses, which at the moment have high demands. Unfortunately, these students are left with no choice but to enrol in General Academic Strand offered by the school therefore setting aside their educational goal rather than to enrol in other schools which will incur additional expenses especially for transportation.

In addition, the faculty found out that Senior High graduates have failed to continue higher education due to financial constraints. In effect, graduates opted to work to various firms and businesses that do not required educational alignment as long as they possess the fundamental skills needed in the successful completion of the required tasks. In order to curb in the aforementioned concerns, Gupitan Integrated School - together with its various stakeholders - adheres to open Technical-Vocational Livelihood (TVL) Track. We firmly believe that by doing so, a more responsive, relevant, and quality education will be delivered to every students in the hinterland area of Langilan District.
