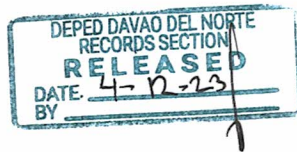
Subject: **THE ALS-LYMPICS 2023**

Date: April 12, 2023

1. Attached is a letter from the Office of the Provincial Governor Edwin I. Jubahib , dated March 21, 2023, on the conduct of the Alternative Learning System ALS-Lympics 2023 on May 6-7, 2023 at the DavNor Sports and Tourism Complex , Tagum City, Davao del Norte.
2. The ALS-Lympics 2023 is a province-wide sport and literacy event- competition to be participated by our ALS learners in Basic Literacy(BL), Elementary, Junior High School (JHS)and Senior High School (SHS) levels who are enrolled in the Learners Information System (LIS) for School Year 2022-2023.
3. The activity shall be participated by the four (4) Divisions in the entire province- Tagum City, Island Garden City of Samal, Panabo City and Davao del Norte. It aims to bring our ALS learners in the camaraderie of sports and literacy arts. Likewise, this shall be part of the advocacy campaign relative to the implementation of ALS programs and projects.
4. List of Events with the corresponding number of learners from each district and names of coaches are enclosed herein.
5. Per DepEd Order NO. 53, s. 2003 or the Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers indicates that attendance/participation in special DepEd Projects and activities which are short term in duration is considered as one of the identified activities eligible for the grant of Service Credits for teachers and Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for non-teaching personnel who have served during Saturdays, Sundays, and including Holidays.
6. Thus, this Office will grant two (2) days service credit to the teachers and COC to the non-teaching personnel, who will render services on May 6-7, 2023, Saturday and Sunday covered in the above-mentioned activity. It is emphasized that the COC is subject to the existing CSC and CSC DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 or non- monetary remuneration for the overtime services rendered.
7. It is expected by this Office that the prescribed restrictions against COVID-19 shall be strictly complied.

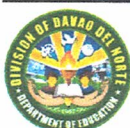


8. Meals and snacks and other incidental expenses during the activity are chargeable to Program Support Funds of Alternative Learning System (ALS) CY 2023, local fund/ MOOE or any other fund available subject to the standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
