Subject: **GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS OF THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT
RESEARCH CONGRESS 2023**

Date: May 12, 2023

1. Relative to the 2023 Student Research Congress on **June 6-7, 2023**, at VIP ClubHouse, this Office informs the mechanics and the guidelines of the competition, to wit:
 - a. Only one entry per district per category (one for quantitative; one for qualitative)
 - b. Each presenter is given a maximum of ten (10) minutes, to present his/ her research output, highlighting the Title, Rationale, Statement or Questions, Model, Method, Results, Discussion, Recommendations/ implications.
 - c. For the time pressure, time starts as the speaker speaks. Color coding is used as to: Green (GO), Yellow (30 SECONDS WARNING), and red (STOP), plus a buzzer or bell. By then, the presenter must stop, finished, or not finished.
 - d. Then, the Question and answer by the Panel of Examiners for 5 minutes. Same time pressure is applied.
 - e. All entries shall receive Certificate as Division Qualifier, together with the coach and school head.
 - f. Winners shall be declared as Champion to 4th runner-up, for both categories.
2. The deadline for the submission of entries shall be on **June 1, 2023, at 5:00 in the afternoon**, via Google Sheet. Further, an online meeting for the coaches, technical working group and committees shall be conducted on **June 2, 2023**. The link shall be forwarded to the GCs of the teams.
3. The entries are also requested to submit their manuscripts in a **SOFTBOUND** copy, with color coding as to: **GREEN** for Quantitative outputs, and **RED** for Qualitative outputs.
4. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity are chargeable against School/ Local Funds/ MOOE, subject to the usual accounting, and auditing rules, and regulations.
5. Everyone is highly encouraged to continually support and recognize the value of equality and diversity of all personnel while complying with the directives set forth by this office.
6. Health Protocols shall be observed at all times.
7. Please be guided accordingly.
