Subject: **ENHANCEMENT TRAINING FOR MAPEH TEACHERS**

Date: October 27, 2023

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 050, s. 2020 titled DepEd Professional Development Priorities for Teachers and School Leaders for School Year 2020-2023 that aims to support the realization of the Department's goal of continuous upskilling and reskilling of teachers and school heads for better learning outcomes, NAFCO Central Elementary School will conduct Enhancement Training for MAPEH Teachers on October 28, 2023 and November 11, 2023.
2. This activity aims to enhance teacher's knowledge and skills in teaching MAPEH for better understanding of the curriculum, content and instructional strategies.
3. Participants of this training are required to bring the following:
 - Arts - lapis, ruler, 24 colors crayon (kiddy and crayola) and a4 bond paper
 - PE - Bilao and labba with three pieces of empty coconut shell (sabsabut or bao), fresh and dried guava leaves
 - Extra t-shirt, towel and wear comfortable pants (jogging pants or leggings)
4. In the conduct of this activity, it is expected that Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) Performance goals and requirements must be made in such a way to recognize universal equality of individuals regardless of gender, religion, ethnicity, and political affiliation.
5. Service credits/compensatory overtime credits (COC) shall be granted to the participants pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003.
6. Travel and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of the said activity shall be chargeable against School MOOE and other local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
