SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- This research congress welcomes participation from researchers currently residing in the Province of Davao del Norte.
 Papers submitted should be a requirement for their academic pursuits, whether in basic education, undergraduate, or graduate studies.
- This research congress will center on studies related to United Nations' Sustainable Goals which will be grouped into three (3) major clusters namely:
- o Cluster 1: Human Well-being and Social Equity This cluster focuses on goals related to improving the well-being of individuals and communities, addressing inequalities, and ensuring social development:
 - Goal 1: No Poverty
 - Goal 2: Zero Hunger
 - Goal 3: Good Health and Well-being
 - Goal 4: Quality Education
 - Goal 5: Gender Equality
 - Goal 10: Reduced Inequality
- o Cluster 2: Environmental Sustainability and Resilience This cluster revolves around goals that aim to protect and restore the environment, promote sustainable resource management, and build resilience to climate change and other environmental challenges:
 - Goal 6: Clean Water and Sanitation
 - Goal 7: Affordable and Clean Energy
 - Goal 13: Climate Action
 - Goal 14: Life Below Water
 - Goal 15: Life on Land
 - Goal 16: Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions
- o Cluster 3: Economic Development and Innovation This cluster centers on goals related to economic growth, employment, innovation, and sustainable industrialization, while considering social and environmental aspects:
 - Goal 8: Decent Work and Economic Growth
 - Goal 9: Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure
 - Goal 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities
 - Goal 12: Responsible Consumption and Production
 - Goal 17: Partnerships for the Goals
- Researchers should submit their full paper (see format guidelines) at dabaononresearch@gmail.com
 for review and approval. The deadline for submission of the research paper is on November 20, 2023.
- The organizing committee will determine the session clusters for the accepted papers to schedule parallel sessions. Researchers whose papers are accepted will receive an email confirming their participation in the paper presentation, along with the program and presentation guidelines not later than **November 25**, 2023.
- Certificates and cash prizes will be given to the best papers.
 - o For every cluster:
 - 1st Prize Php 5,000
 - 2nd Prize Php 3,000
 - 3rd Prize Php 2,000
 - Special Award Php 2,000

FULL PAPER FORMAT GUIDELINES

- The manuscript should not exceed 5000 words excluding the reference list (A4 Size pages, typed Justify, .5 space, font size 12, font type- Times New Roman). The manuscript should be in MS Word.
- The research paper must not have been previously published in any journals. It should have been written between January 2021 and November 2023.
- The manuscript must be free from plagiarism. Grammarly/Turnitin will be used to assess the similarity index of the manuscripts, and those with a plagiarism score exceeding 15% will be automatically disqualified from presentation.
- The referencing should be based on APA 7th Edition both in in-text and bibliography.
- The paper should conform to the IMRAD format.
 - o Cover Page
 - A.Title of the paper;
 - B.Name of author/s including the adviser as co-author;
 - C.Name of the institution:
 - D. Date research was accomplished.
 - Abstract The abstract is divided into the following four sections with these headings: Title,
 Background, Methods and Findings, Conclusions, and Keywords. Abstract body should be one paragraph, single-spaced, not to exceed 250 words with 3 to 5 keywords.
 - o **Introduction** The introduction should discuss the rationale and the purpose of the study in the broader context. Include a brief review of the key literature. The introduction should conclude with a brief statement of the overall objective of the research and the significance of the study.
 - Method The relevant methodology or supporting information related to data should be provided.
 References for the study's design and statistical methods should be provided from the standard works. The ethical consideration of the paper might be included here.
 - Result The result section should include all relevant positive and negative findings. Supporting literature is not necessary for this part. The focus should be on the presentation and analysis of the result.
 - Discussion The discussion should be concise, and it should start with a summary of the main findings followed by your conclusions with supporting literature. The recommendations based on the findings of the study might also be presented.
 - o References The reference list should be in APA 7th edition format. Arrange alphabetically.
