1. In accordance with DepEd Memorandum No. 005, s. 2023 “Conduct of the 2023 Palarong Pambansa” and Sections 6,8,9, and 10 of Rule II of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 10588, otherwise known as the Palarong Pambansa of 2013, the field is hereby informed of the selection of quality athletes through the conduct of **Kapalong Municipal Athletic Meet on January 5-6, 2023 at Maniki Central Elementary School Sped Center, Maniki, Kapalong, Davao del Norte.**
2. This activity will be participated in by the three (3) districts in the municipality of Kapalong: Kapalong East, Kapalong West, and Langilan District, both from Elementary and Secondary schools.
3. Anent to this, all elementary and secondary schools in the Municipality of Kapalong are expected to participate in the sports where they can compete and bring their selected participants.
4. The teaching and non-teaching personnel who participate in the event and render their vacation time and service shall be given service credits as per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 and CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 respectively.
5. As per compliance with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, titled “No Disruption of Classes Policy,” School Heads shall ensure that the classes are taken care of accordingly.
6. All expenses relative to this activity shall be charged against school MOOE or school local funds, subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Furthermore, the Equal Opportunities Principle (EOP) shall always be observed in participating in this activity, where all individuals are fully recognized regardless of gender, religion, ethnicity, and political affiliation.



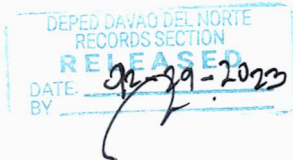
