It is advised that no teachers will participate in this training to avoid disruption of classes and not violate the new mandate by the Office of the DepEd Secretary.


All identified participants are requested to bring laptops for the practicum on ADEPT.

The Commission on Population and Development (POPCOM) - Region XI is enthusiastic in strengthening the partnership with Department of Education (DepEd) - Regional Office XI in the implementation of the Philippine Population and Development Program (PPDP) through Executive Order 141 that focuses the attention of the government on the issue of pregnancies among adolescents in the Philippines which is currently labeled as an "urgent national priority" and prioritizes the implementation of measures addressing adolescent pregnancies in the country thereby mobilizing government agencies for the said purpose.

DepEd XI have been an active partner of POPCOM Region XI in empowering Davaoño youths through utilizing the Sexually Healthy and Personally Empowered Adolescents (SHAPE-A) Module in the implementation of Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) in schools and in other learning systems and modalities. A first batch of training of trainers was conducted in 2021 to eight hundred sixty-five (865) ARH Coordinators from all eleven (11) Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in Region XI.

The JRGAD/SHAPE-A Module is one of POPCOM's training tool for adolescents which aims to increase the awareness of young people on issues and concerns affecting them particularly on fertility awareness, sexual and reproductive health; and equip young people with practical life skills to be able to deal with the demands of everyday life, against risky sexual and non-sexual behavior.

To further equip more of our ARH Coordinators, teachers, guidance counselors and in-school health service providers with additional knowledge and skills in the implementation and operationalization of the CSE to our adolescents, we deemed it fit to hit the ground running in preparing our educators in contributing to the strategies in preventing early, unintended and repeated pregnancy among the 10-17 year olds. Thus, we would like to request the participation of your **forty-five (45) ARH Coordinators/ Guidance Advocates/counselors, Teachers of CSE Subjects, and in-school Health Service Providers** from the eleven (11) SDOs to attend the **Batch 2 Training of Trainers on JRGAD/SHAPE-A Module Toolkit** which will be conducted on **September 21-24, 2022** in Davao City, to wit:
