The World Rabies Day is celebrated every 28th of September and it aims to raise awareness and advocate rabies elimination globally. This year marks the 16th World Rabies Day with the theme: "One Health, Zero Death", which will highlight the connection of the environment with both people and animals.

In this connection, the Bureau of the Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), enjoins all public elementary and secondary schools to participate the one-day celebration of the 2022 WORLD RABIES DAY on September 28, 2022, Wednesday. The event aims to strengthen rabies prevention education and promotion of animal bite prevention and treatment/management, responsible pet ownership, and the Rabies Law.
