- 2. In line with this that there will be a **Division Orientation** for the **ADMINISTRATION OF NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT TEST** on **January 13**, **2023 (Friday)** at **1:00** in the afternoon to be held at the **DavNor Gym**, **Mankiam**, **Tagum City Davao del Norte**.
- 3. The **participants** of this orientation are the Education Program Supervisors, Public School District Supervisors, Secondary School Heads of public and private schools and Integrated Schools Head.
- 4. Further, additional ten (10) participants who are school heads of the elementary level per district shall be included for the preparation in the future assessment and interfacing.
- 5. Travelling and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. It is also emphasized that while in the activity, the personnel shall observe and follow the minimum health protocols wherever they may be in

accordance with the IATF and DOH rules and guidelines, while the equal opportunity principle must always be upheld.
