The Sites Titling Office under the Office of the Undersecretary for Legal and Legislative Affairs will be conducting the activity titled "Assessment with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR): Joint Assessment and Planning on Presidential Proclamations and Special Patents Titling for Public Schools," scheduled on 26-28 November 2025 within Metro Manila.

This activity is part of the implementation of the 4<sup>th</sup> Memorandum of Agreement (MOA 4) between the Department of Education (DepEd) and the DENR, involving the facilitation of the issuance of Presidential Proclamations and Special Patents for six hundred sixty (660) untitled DepEd school sites, and other commitments of DENR-Land Management Bureau (LMB) in support of DepEd's titling efforts.

The activity aims to serve as a forum to: a) discuss and establish a uniform understanding of DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2015-01, dated 4 March 2015 or the Guidelines for the Processing and Issuance of Special Patents for Public School Sites under Republic Act No. 10023;<sup>1</sup> to facilitate the approval of survey and titling of the 660 school sites covered under MOA 4; b) discuss the transfer of funds to all concerned Regional Offices relative to the issuance of Presidential Proclamations and/or Special Patents (Titles) over school sites; c) identify and address issues and concerns on the titling of school sites; and d) assess the physical accomplishments of the DENR-DepEd School Sites Titling Project under MOAs 1, 2

& 3, pursuant to DAO No. 2015-01. It will also set additional targets and commitments for the titling of public school sites under DENR jurisdiction.

In this regard, all Regional and Division Offices are requested to send **one (1) representative** who is directly involved in school sites matters. In case the Division Lawyer is not available, the Technical Assistant (TA) may attend, provided that a Travel Authority is secured and a written justification for attendance is submitted.

Participants' travel and incidental expenses shall be charged to their respective local funds, subject to the existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.

Participants are required to register online at <https://forms.gle/iRsmKVj8YJKhMSUFA> on or before **November 15, 2025**. Registered participants will be issued certificates after the event, while those who register late will have their certificates forwarded through the Records Division to their respective Regional or Division Offices.


