




- 3. The abovementioned activities have the following objectives:
 - a. Design contextually relevant and developmentally appropriate SEL modules that support teachers in integrating SEL across various grade levels and learning areas;
 - b. Enhance teachers' understanding of core SEL competencies such as self-awareness, self-management, social awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision-making:
 - c. Provide practical strategies and classroom applications that promote empathy, emotional regulation, conflict resolution, and positive behavior among learners;
 - d. Align SEL content with the *Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST)* and other related national education-related laws and policies such as R.A. No. 10627 (*Anti-Bullying Act of 2013*) and R.A. No. 11036 (*Mental Health Act*); and
 - e. Contribute to the creation of safe, inclusive, and learner-centered environments by equipping teachers with tools to support students' social and emotional well-being.
- 4. A National Technical Working Group (NTWG) on SEL Development has been established, composed of select school head/s, guidance counselor/s, guidance designate/s, and subject-matter expert/s who are expected to participate in all related activities.
- 5. For reference, attached are the **List of NTWG Members/Participants (Enclosure 1)** and the **Activity Matrix (Enclosure 2)** for the first activity.


