- In line with the Department of Education's commitment to ensuring equitable access to quality education, the Office, through the Field Technical Assistance Division, will conduct monitoring visits to Last Mile Schools and Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA) Schools) on the 2nd and 3rd Quarter of FY 2025.


