5. The Equal Opportunity Principle (EOP) shall be strictly observed, ensuring inclusive and respectful engagement across all school representatives.



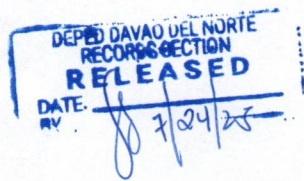
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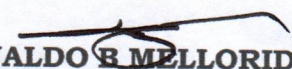
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6. Traveling and other incidental expenses shall be charged against School MOOE.
