- Classes of the Teacher -participants who shall attend the activity shall be arranged accordingly to avoid disruption of classes per DepEd order No. 9, s. 2005.
- 4. Service credit shall be given for the services rendered during Saturday as stipulated in DepEd order No. 53, s. 2003.
- 5. Travel and other incidental expenses such as registration fee of Fifty Pesos (P50.00) to cover expenses on tarpaulin, certificates, meals and tokens for trainers shall be charged against the school MOOE. All participants must bring 2 pcs of triangular bandage (size 40 inches x 4 inches)first aid kit, meals/snacks and extra shirts.
